

## **Definite and indefinite articles**

We use the **definite article** 'the' before a noun when the identity of the noun is clear to the reader.

E.g. The CEO of Apple is Tim Cook. (There is only one CEO at Apple.)

We use the **indefinite articles** 'a' and 'an' before a singular noun when its identity is either very general or not known.

For nouns with a vowel sound, we use 'an' and for nouns with a consonant sound, we use 'a'.

E.g. I sent him a PDF this afternoon. (We don't know which PDF you sent.)

E.g. Tiffany is an English native speaker. (She is not the only native speaker.)
